




## **Celebrating 70 years - Good Neighbor Settlement House in Brownsville, TX**

. . . serves both homeless families in the area and 300-500 migrants a day. Migrant families are served a hot meal, given a folder with legal advice, and presented with a tote bag filled with daily necessities. In 2022, The Good Neighbor Settlement House served 102,000 migrants. As one of our National Mission Institutions, GNSH has been serving the hungry and homeless in Brownsville for 70 years. Some other programs include hot showers & laundry for homeless clients, a food pantry, an on-site demo kitchen for nutrition classes, and a community garden.
